



MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 01-2016

TO : ALL CINEMA OPERATORS, MOTION PICTURE PRODUCERS & DISTRIBUTORS, OPTICAL MEDIA PRODUCERS & EXHIBITORS, MTRCB DEPUTIES AND ALL PERSONS REQUIRED BY LAW TO APPLY FOR PERMITS WITH THE MTRCB

SUBJECT : NEW DESIGN AND EFFECTIVITY OF PERMIT FOR THEATRICAL EXHIBITION

DATE : 24 FEBRUARY 2016

Pursuant to the Board's power to supervise and regulate the grant of theatrical permits to exhibit, and in the light of its authority to exercise such powers and functions as may be necessary or incidental to the fulfillment of its mandate (§ 3(d) in relation to § 3(k), P.D. No. 1986), the Board hereby promulgates the new design and layout of theatrical permits to exhibit, and the proper display thereof, as follows:

- 1) All Theatrical Permits to Exhibit shall contain the following information:
 - a) Permit Number
 - b) Date of Issuance
 - c) Date of Expiration
 - d) The document title "PERMIT FOR THEATRICAL EXHIBITION"
 - e) Title of the Film
 - f) Classification Rating of the Film following the prescribed color-coded film pictogram under Memorandum Circular No. 10-2102 dated 03 October 2012
 - g) Reason/s for Classification

A handwritten signature in black ink, consisting of a stylized, cursive script.

- h) Cast of the Film
 - i) Film Producer
 - j) Film Running Time
 - k) Country of Origin of the Film
 - l) Name of MTRCB Review Committee Members
 - m) Name and Signature of MTRCB Chairperson.
- 2) The film's classification rating contained in the permit for theatrical exhibition shall be in full color following the prescribed color-coded film pictogram under Memorandum Circular No. 10-2012 dated 03 October 2012.
- 3) All permits for theatrical exhibition existing and valid as of the date of this Circular shall continue to be honored. However, any certified true copy thereof requested subsequent to the date of this Circular must be made and issued following the new design and layout of theatrical permits to exhibit.
- 4) Pursuant to Section 8 of P.D. 1986, all permits for theatrical exhibition shall be posted or displayed in conspicuous places near the entrances of theaters or places of exhibitions, more specifically at the ticket selling area; provided that wherever said permits are posted, these shall be clearly readable by, and readily accessible to, patrons even before they purchase any movie ticket/s.

Any violation of this Memorandum Circular shall be dealt with further to the provisions of Section 11 of P.D. 1986 and Chapter XIII of the 2004 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations.

This Circular shall take effect after fifteen (15) days following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation and filing with the Office of the National Administrative Register in the University of the Philippines Law Center, as required under the Administrative Code of 1987.


