



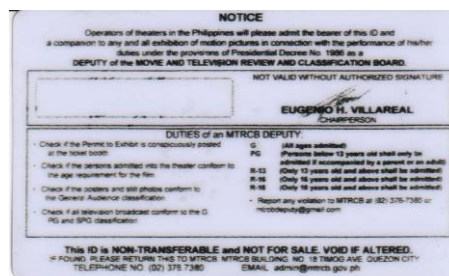

## PUBLIC ADVISORY

The Board has recently monitored the proliferation of fake MTRCB Deputy Identification Cards. The public is advised that any person caught using a falsified MTRCB Deputy ID shall be criminally charged for the following: Estafa under Article 315 of the Revised Penal Code; Falsification of Public Document under Article 172 of the Revised Penal Code; and Usurpation of Official Function under Article 177 of the Revised Penal Code.

The monitored fake MTRCB Deputy IDs have identification numbers that begin with **2018** and have purported validity of until **28 December 2018**. Below is a facsimile of the fake MTRCB Deputy ID:



In the past few days, the Board has filed numerous criminal cases in the Metropolitan Trial Courts of Quezon City against persons found using fake MTRCB Deputy IDs. They were detained by the Philippine National Police (PNP) pending inquest proceedings.
